



Baja 500 Race Information

- **Approximate Race Mileage/Start Times/Time Limit** have been changed from original schedule as the final course distance is now at **542.12 miles**. This increase in distance requires that we change the race start times: Motos and quads start time as been moved to **3:30 am** Saturday, June 2, and the Trophy Trucks start at **8:00 am**. **The time limit has been extended to 22 hours.**
- **Baja 500 Course Map** is now posted on website under Race Info.
- **Shortcut for ALL Sportsman Classes, and Class 11** is required due to extended race distance. Our goal is to give you a better opportunity to finish and be safe. Other slower classes may elect to use shortcut if agreeable to all entrants in a class, Contact Jose G. (Race Dir.) or Christine Wait (Asst R.D.) for additional information.
- **Any Sportsman Class, and Pro Moto and Quad participants reaching a checkpoint after closing time** will be stopped and removed from the race. You will be classified as a DNF and will receive start points. Failure to stop as directed will result in disqualification and no points. If you reach a checkpoint location and the SCORE Staff is not there, you have timed out and must pull off the course.
- **Hydration is a must!** Portions of this course will run through areas with extreme temperatures and will require above average hydration. Do not wait until race morning to start to hydrate! Experts recommend starting at least 48 hours before strenuous exercise!
- **Moto and Quad riders** are required to utilize a hydration pack (CamelBak® or equivalent), if scheduled to ride in high heat sections of course. Minimum liquid capacity is one (1) liter, and two (2) liter size is required if temperature is expected over 80° F (26.7° C)
- **Fuel Orders** should be placed with you supplier **immediately!** Review you anticipated needs due to the increased mileage for this event. You may need to modify orders you have already placed.
- **Stella Video** – It is highly recommended that all competitors and their entire support crew be familiar with all features and operation of this important device! The video is available on the SCORE website/Race Info/Select Baja 500 logo and then the Stella Video option.
- **Pre-Tech** will be available on Tuesday and Wednesday, May 29-30 at Playa Hermosa Beach 1.1 miles south of Riviera Convention Center.
- **Fast Lane** will be available during tech days for all vehicles that pre-teched on Tuesday and Wednesday.
- **Racer Brief and Penalty Document** will be posted on website as soon as available
