



2019 SCORE In-Class Start Order Policy

The 2019 Start position order for each event will be determined as follows:

- **SCORE San Felipe 250** – There will be a draw to determine the in-class start order for all classes.
- **SCORE Baja 500** – San Felipe 250 results will determine the in-class start order for all classes,
- **Lucerna SCORE Baja 400** – There will be a draw to determine the in-class start order for all classes.
- **SCORE Baja 1000** – The Lucerna SCORE Baja 400 results will determine the in-class starting order.

To summarize the above, start positions for the San Felipe 250 will be a draw and your results from the San Felipe 250 will determine the start positions for the SCORE Baja 500. Start positions for the Lucerna SCORE Baja 400 will be a draw. Your result from the Lucerna SCORE Baja 400 will determine your Baja 1000 start position.

NOTE: Refer to the Baja 500 and Baja 1000 sections below for additional details on how the In-Class Start Order will be administered for each event. Prior to each event, refer to the Schedule of Events to determine the specific registration time and day deadlines referenced within these documents.

San Felipe 250

Start positions will be a draw to determine the in-class start order for all classes. Teams that register and pay race fees and memberships in full (100%) before the San Felipe 250 on-line registration deadline will be entered into the draw for start positions. Participants who do not register before the deadline or have not paid 100% of all fees will NOT be included in the draw.

Participants who do not register and pay the required fees before the close of the on-line registration will be treated as a Late Race Entry.

Late Race Entries received after the online registration deadline date and time, or not paid in full (100%) will be placed in the order the entry was received behind the teams who met the online registration requirement to be in the draw.

Baja 500

The Driver of Record/Rider of Record (DOR/ROR) that finishes first in class in the San Felipe event will start first in their respective class at the Baja 500. The DOR/ROR that finishes second in class in the San Felipe race will start second in their respective class at the Baja 500 and so on. If a team uses an alternate driver or rider in the San Felipe 250 event, the official DOR/ROR will be the one that is given the start position at the Baja 500.

Draw # 1 – If a San Felipe 250 entry finished as a DNF they will be entered into this drawing to determine their Baja 500 start positions in their respective classes. This group will start behind the teams credited with a finish at the San Felipe race. Teams disqualified at San Felipe will be given start positions behind teams with a DNF.

NOTE: Start positions earned at San Felipe 250 will be reserved only until the close of on-line registration for the Baja 500. San Felipe participants who do not register and pay fees (100%) before the close of the on-line registration will be treated as a Late Race Entry.

Draw # 2 - Teams not entered in the San Felipe 250 event that register and pay fees in full (100%) before the Baja 500 online registration deadline will be entered into Drawing #2 and will start behind the San Felipe participants in Draw #1.

Late Race Entries received after the online registration deadline date and time, will be placed in the order the entry was received behind the San Felipe 250 participating teams and those who met the online registration requirements to be in the draw.

Lucerna SCORE Baja 400

Start positions will be a draw to determine the in-class start order for all classes. Teams that register and pay race fees and memberships in full (100%) before the Baja 400 on-line registration deadline will be entered into the draw for start positions. Participants who do not register before the deadline or have not paid 100% of all fees will NOT be included in the draw.

Participants who do not register and pay the required fees before the close of the on-line registration will be treated as a Late Race Entry.

Late Race Entries received after the online registration deadline date and time, or not paid in full (100%) will be placed in the order the entry was received behind the teams who met the online registration requirement to be in the draw

Baja 1000

The Driver of Record/Rider of Record (DOR/ROR) that finishes first in class in the Baja 400 event will start first in their respective class at the Baja 1000. The DOR/ROR that finishes second in class in the Baja 400 race will start second in their respective class at the Baja 1000 and so on. If a team uses an alternate driver or rider in the Baja 400 event, the official DOR/ROR will be the one that is given the start position at the Baja 1000.

Draw # 1 – If a Baja 400 entry finished as a DNF they will be entered into this drawing to determine their Baja 1000 start position in their respective classes. This group will start behind the teams credited with a finish at the Baja 400. Teams disqualified at the Baja 400 will be given start positions behind teams with a DNF.

NOTE: Start positions earned at the Baja 400 will be reserved only until the close of on-line registration for the Baja 1000. Baja 400 participants who do not register and pay fees (100%) before the close of the on-line registration will be treated as a Late Race Entry.

Draw # 2 - Teams not entered in the Baja 400 event that register and pay fees in full (100%) before the Baja 1000 online registration deadline will be entered into Drawing #2 and will start behind the Baja 400 participants in Draw #1.

Late Race Entries received after the online registration deadline date and time, will be placed in the order the entry was received behind the Baja 400 participating teams and those who met the online registration requirements to be in the draw.

Effective January 1, 2019
