



## 2019 Stella Tracking Information

SCORE International and Anube Sport America will again be partnered for use of Anube tracking and safety devices for the 2019 season. During the course of the year, we will be working together to migrate the use of the Stella III devices to the Stella III EVO product, starting with the San Felipe 250. All features of the Stella III are forward compatible with the Stella III EVO product. (For example, push to pass will work between the devices.) Transition from the Stella III to the Stella III EVO system does require an upgrade to the Stella III's power cords and antennas. Refer below for additional information.

**New SPICA Device** - We will be adding an additional device called the SPICA (pronounced SPEAK-Ah). This SPICA unit is being added as a second device and does not require any equipment purchase by the teams. The SPICA unit serves as a data logger and an additional option to request assistance during a medical emergency. The SPICA unit will be provided to each team at the start line of the race. Four (4) wheel vehicle teams will be provided information at the drivers meeting regarding required placement of the SPICA unit in the vehicle.

**Motorcycle and Quad Riders** - You will be required to carry the SPICA unit on your person and pass the unit from rider to rider. This is in case you are separated from your moto/quad, you will have the unit on your person and will be able to request assistance from the SPICA unit. Refer to the Racer Brief regarding penalties for failing to transfer the unit between riders.

**Phasing-In Stella III EVO devices** - For the San Felipe 250 the only classes impacted are Trophy Truck, Trophy Truck Legends, Trophy Truck Spec and Class 1. Other classes will be notified prior to each event when you need to prepare for the upgrade. Transitioning from the Stella III to the Stella III EVO system does require an upgrade to the Stella III's power cords and antennas. The cost of the upgrade is \$50 plus shipping. **Anube Device Insurance** – Race teams are responsible for any damage or loss of the Stella III, Stella III EVO, and the SPICA units. To cover damage or loss during the race event, you will purchase the insurance directly from Anube during Tech/Contingency days. The cost is \$40 payable directly to Anube.

**New Anube Pre-Run Service** - Stella units for pre-running are now available for lease from Anube. The unit provides the race course and includes tracking for chassis teams and family. The lease of the Stella for pre-running can be ordered on-line at <https://usa.anubesport.com/product-category/score-international>. The units will ship on March 15th and will be activated with the course route on May 23rd.
