



# Trailblazer Class

## Vintage Era 1982 and Before

### DEFINITION

Era correct 1982 and older Trucks, Buggies and Bugs

### Competition Number Range - Letter V+Original 3-Digit Competition Number

Entrants in this class shall comply with all applicable SCORE General Regulations.

### COMPETITION REGULATIONS

This class is an open class and all components will be considered open unless restricted herein. Exceptions to the following restrictions are reserved for the actual historic vehicle as raced in the era. Documentation that proves the vehicle was raced during the era without the following restrictions is required to be granted a waiver from these restrictions. Any waivers of the following restrictions will be at the discretion of SCORE. Vehicles wishing to enter this class must submit pictures of the vehicle to SCORE Technical Director prior to chassis inspection. They must include detailed close-ups of the suspension system, chassis and cage to be approved as a vintage vehicle. Vehicles that raced SCORE previously, and do not meet current specifications, can possibly be modified and "Grandfathered" into current competition. Contact SCORE for information

## Buggies and Bugs

### SUSPENSION COMPONENTS

#### Front Suspension

Front suspension is based on VW Type 1 ball joint or link pin style. Any manufacturer's beam of two (2) steel torsion tubes may be used. Any manufacturer's torsion bars are allowed. Front trailing arms (torsion arms) may be reinforced or replaced with arms up to 2.5" longer than stock VW arms. Suspension limiters are allowed. Spindles, link pins, ball joints, and shock mounting locations are open. Front suspension track width is open.

#### Rear suspension

Rear suspension is based on VW Type 1 IRS, swing axle and 3 and 5 link rear suspensions such as those manufactured during the era by Chenoweth and others if not modified. IRS swing arms may be modified or replaced as long as the VW IRS swing arm length does not exceed 3" wider and 3" longer than stock VW rear swing arms. Outboard bus reduction gears are allowed. The use of "micro stub hubs" is prohibited. A single torsion bar per wheel of any manufacture is allowed. Torsion bars must remain inside the torsion housing. Rear suspension track width is open. The entire outer CV must remain inboard of the trailing arm inner bearing.

**CR 10 SHOCK ABSORBERS and BUMP STOPS** No limit on the number of shock absorbers. 2" smooth body shocks only, reservoirs are permitted. No bypass shocks, air bumps or coil over shocks allowed.



## **Trailblazer Class - Vintage Era 1982 and Before** **Buggies and Bugs - cont'd**

**CR 11 SECONDARY SUSPENSION** Secondary torsion bars are permitted to control only the final 30% of bump travel.

**CR 12 WHEELS and TIRES** Any rims allowed. No wheel spacers allowed. Tires are limited to a maximum diameter of 33".

**CR 23 ENGINE and ENGINE DISPLACEMENT** Engine must utilize VW series type 1, displacement is open.

**CR 24 ENGINE REPLACEMENT**

**CR 25 TRANSMISSION** Must be stock VW type 1 or type 2 transaxle housing. Any internal or external modifications to housing are allowed. No more than four (4) forward speeds are allowed. Any gear ratio combinations but only VW type gears (helical cut gears) may be used. Any internal modifications are allowed. May use aftermarket side covers.

VW Bugs are required to have fenders. The removal of fenders for any reason other than damage incurred during an accident, after the race has officially started, will cause the vehicle to be disqualified.

**CR 50 IDENTIFICATION MARKINGS** - Numbers must be black numerals on white background. Original competition number (up to 3 digits) may be used with a **letter "V" preceding** the numerals. ### SUSPENSION COMPONENTS

#### Suspension

The suspension must be of stock concept for the chassis with full length original chassis. Leaf springs must be of a semi elliptical design and must have a single fixed pivot (single shackle). A maximum of 2 rear links are allowed. Four-wheel drive trucks must have solid front axle 4-wheel drive.

**CR 10 SHOCK ABSORBERS and BUMP STOPS** No limit on the number of shock absorbers. 2" (O.D.) shocks only (no coilover), reservoirs are permitted. One 2.5" bypass shock may be used per wheel if no other shocks are used. Air bump stops are permitted.

**CR 11 SECONDARY SUSPENSION**

**CR 23 ENGINE and ENGINE DISPLACEMENT** Engine must match make of the body of the truck. Engines must be normally aspirated and based on OEM engines available prior to, and including 1982.

Trucks are required to have fenders that must be securely attached to the vehicle. The removal of fenders for any reason other than damage incurred during an accident, after the race has officially started, will cause the vehicle to be disqualified.

CR 48 CHASSIS and BODY - The body style must have existed in this era of 1982 or earlier. Must have steel cab and operating doors. The chassis must be stock. Trucks must have full bed sides.
