

Frequently Asked Questions About the 2020 Baja 500



- Q. Will there be a Driver/Rider meeting before the Baja 500? 9.12.20
- **A.** Due to the Bio-Security Protocol requirements, groups of over 10 are not allowed. We will post information under RACE INFO on checkpoints, speed zones and VCP's.
- **Q.** What is the deadline to sign-up for a Medical Lane Passes? How many passes can I get for my team? 9.10.20
- **A.** Deadline is Saturday, September 19th at 5 p.m. Each registered racer can request a maximum of five (5) passes per entry.
- **Q.** When will course information like the GPS files be available? 9.09.20
- **A.** GPS files are scheduled to post at approximately 5:00 pm tomorrow, Sept. 10th.
- **Q.** Will I need to furnish my own PPE and my team? 9.09.20
- **A.** Yes, everyone must provide their own PPE gear. To determine your needs, refer to the COVID-19 Guidelines and Controlled Access documents on this website.
- Q. How many team members can I bring to the race with me? 9.08.20
- **A.** In addition to DOR and Co-Drivers and ROR and Co-Riders, each team will receive up to four (4) **essential team member** wristbands. These bands allow entry into most controlled access areas (CAA). All banded persons must be 16 years of age or older.
- **Q.** Since this year everything is so different for this Baja 500, **w**ill we still be able to sign-up for possible contingency awards? *9.07.20*
- **A.** Yes, contingency awards are still being offered by all of the companies listed on our website under Contingency Awards heading. Information on how to complete and submit your form is under Race Info and will also be in your Racer Packet.
