



Planning For Contingency At the Baja 1000

The SCORE Baja 1000 is a 100% restricted access event and the Contingency process will be much different than previous SCORE races. Guidelines for registering your vehicle for possible contingency awards are listed below.

- Review the manufacturer Contingency Award List on our website to determine manufacturers participating in program.
- Baja 1000 Contingency Declaration Form is included in your driver packet. You must complete this document **before** entering Tech line on your designated day. Refer to Event Schedule for day your class is scheduled for Tech.
- On the Contingency Declaration Form, check **only** the products that you have installed on your vehicle.
- **IMPORTANT** - All manufacturers stickers for products you have installed on vehicle must be on vehicle before entering Tech line. Plan now for the stickers you need by contacting your equipment supplier for stickers you require.
- Sponsors including PCI Radios and Raceline Wheels will be located on contingency row. Stickers will be available for their products. BFGoodrich Tires stickers must be obtained in advance from your distributor.
- No manufacturer stickers will be available directly from SCORE at this race. It is your responsibility to secure the stickers that you need before the Baja 500.
- Your Contingency form will be collected when your vehicle enters the tech area. Double check that all information is complete on the form before Tech. Retain the yellow copy for your records.
- Take pictures of your vehicle with all stickers in place before entering the Tech line. Pictures may be requested by one or more contingency manufacturers as proof of compliance with their sticker requirements before honoring awards.

Reminder... Large SCORE International stickers (9"x3.5") must be clearly visible on both sides of vehicle to qualify for any possible awards. Stickers are included in driver packet.
