



Bio-Security Protocol Against COVID-19

Like many places in the U.S. and worldwide, Baja California has experienced various challenges because of the COVID-19 situation and therefore is continuing to apply strict Bio-security Protocols in the Hotels, Restaurants and other events and services.

When participating in the upcoming SCORE San Felipe 250 please be reminded that you are a guest of the people and governments of Baja California, Mexicali and San Felipe who not only welcome you, but at the same time urge you to follow at all times important health measures such as wearing a facemask, maintaining safe distance from other persons and constantly sanitizing your hands.

At SCORE International the health and safety of our racers, sponsors, fans, staff and citizens of Baja California are our highest priority. SCORE will be requiring masks properly worn, and social distancing at all times. There will be no spectators allowed in the SCORE compound for Registration days, Qualifying, Tech/Contingency day, nor the Start/Finish area.

COVID-19 RECOMMENDATIONS WHEN VISITING BAJA CALIFORNIA

1. Wear a face mask by covering your mouth and nose at all times and a face shield when you are exposed to others for extended periods of time. It is strongly recommended to bring your own face masks and shields.
2. Practice Social Distancing by always maintaining a minimum distance of 4.5 to 6 ft. (1.5 to 2.0 meters) between yourself and others.
3. Use hand sanitizer and a sanitizing mat when offered at the entrance to a restaurant, hotel, store or any other venue.
4. Wash your hands frequently with soap and water or use hand sanitizer especially if you use a rest room or touch common surfaces, exchange money, receipts, keys, credit cards, badges, etc. It is recommended that you carry a small bottle of hand sanitizer with you.
5. It is important to remember that before removing your face mask and/or face shield you must thoroughly wash your hands with soap and water or disinfect with hand sanitizer and avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
6. Avoid contact with groups larger than 10 persons as they all must wear a face mask and maintain social distancing even among groups of friends and associates.
7. Whenever waiting in line at the entrance of a restaurant, hotel, or store be sure you are wearing your face mask properly and are practicing social distancing.
8. As COVID-19 is a highly contagious respiratory virus authorities recommend that attendees to any area with a crowd must always correctly wear a face mask, practice social distancing, and avoid handshakes and hugging.

COVID-19 RECOMMENDATIONS - *continued*

9. Avoid sharing cups, plates, spoons and other items and in general anything that has not been properly sanitized.
10. Health Authorities recommend that a combined use of face mask and/or face shield increase the security of persons in places where dust, sand fragments and smoke is created
11. If you camp or set-up around the race course do not forget to pick up your trash and dispose of all materials such as face masks, shields, gloves, etc. in a separate bag and spray them with disinfectant.
12. According to Health Authorities any person that has respiratory symptoms, a cough, sore throat, headache, and fever, loss of smell or taste and general discomfort should not come to the race. If any person already at the race develops any of these symptoms, they should self-isolate and permanently use a face mask and face shield until receiving medical attention.
