



To All SCORE INTERNATIONAL Racers, Teams and Contingency Sponsors:

Once again SCORE INTERNATIONAL® is proud to present the 27th running of the “MASTERCRAFT SAFETY TECATE SCORE SAN FELIPE 250®”, happening in San Felipe, Baja California on March 8th thru the 10th 2013.

In a continuous effort to provide you with the most convenience to race in Mexico, we have established close communication with Mexican Officials from the Baja California State Government, Mexicali Municipal Government, Convention and Tourism Committee, as well as with the Customs Administration in the city of Mexicali, in order to reach agreements to expedite and facilitate the process of crossing the border to participate in this event.

As result of such approach with Customs Authorities we have been advised, that the process of crossing the Border should be as follows:

1. All Racers, Crews, Teams and Contingency sponsors, shall cross the Border thru the new Port of Entry called **Mexicali II** (located to the east the regular tourist Border in Calexico) and go thru the Self Declaration Lane, there will be a **WELCOME SCORE RACERS** banner showing a dedicated lane. Regular passenger vehicles and motor homes may cross by the Calexico Downtown Port of Entry.
2. Every Racer, Team crew member and Contingency sponsor, shall be prepared with a complete and detailed inventory of all the items (parts, tools, equipment, etc.) that will be used during your participation in the race. The Mexican Customs Authority may, or may not request it, **please be prepared!**
3. Nobody, absolutely nobody is allowed to bring any type of fuel or competition fuel (high octane) into the Country, but only the one in the fuel cells of the race cars. Additional fuel in other type of containers will be seized by Customs officials.

The Customs officials will have a complete and updated Competitor Entry List, as well as a List of the Contingency companies participating in this event, **please make sure to identify yourselves as racers or sponsors with the Officials at the Port of Entry; this will expedite and facilitate the process of crossing the Border.**

4. Remember that you should carry proper ID and valid and current Passport, in order to obtain a Tourist Visa (called DNI) if you are planning to stay longer than 72 hours or go further south of San Felipe. This can be obtained at the Border, and they are valid for multiple entries during a period of 180 days. (Approximate cost is \$21.00 USD payable at a Bank next to the Immigration Office which is open 24/7)
5. Observing these simple rules will insure that you have a happy and pleasant stay while enjoying racing with SCORE INTERNATIONAL.
6. Weapons, firearms, ammunition, explosives and drugs of any type are forbidden in Mexico.
7. Driving a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol or drugs is illegal in Mexico, and if you are stopped by a Police officer you may be subject to arrest and prosecution. Always carry a valid and current Driver's License and proper Insurance when operating a motor vehicle in Mexico, even when driving a race car.
8. The Baja California State Government has set two direct hotlines for assistance:

066 is the line to report accidents, emergencies, or incidents requiring Police, Rescue, Fire or Paramedics, it is a 24 hours bilingual hotline connected to all law enforcement agencies.

078 is a direct Tourist assistance hotline to guide and answer any questions you may have while traveling in the State of Baja California.

We look forward to see you in San Felipe, and wish you a safe and fun time while racing Off-Road in Mexico.
