



Start-Finish Controlled Access Area

The SCORE Staff and Volunteers appreciate all your support when choosing to race in this SCORE event. Sometimes difficult decisions need to be made for the safety of all individuals in attendance. Starting with the San Felipe 250, SCORE is implementing a policy that will require all individuals with access to the start finish areas sign a waiver and obtain a SCORE wristband. This has not been an easy decision to make but safety of all race participants, Media Personnel, VIP's, guests, Staff and Volunteers is our foremost concern.

Each of our four (4) events this year will have different requirements for access. This document addresses only the San Felipe 250. Each registered team will be authorized to request up to ten (10) wristbands for team and family for access to the finish area just after the interview ramp. To obtain the waiver form you can go to the Score Website, select Race Info, San Felipe 250 logo, and scroll down to the Waivers menu item. Select the waiver titled **Controlled Access Area**. For anyone under the age of 18 you will also need to print the **Minor Waiver** form. (Forms will also be available in the Ensenada office.) Have each person read and sign the waiver form and complete the minor form for each person under 18. Bring the completed forms to on-site registration to obtain your wristbands. You cannot have one person write down and sign for everyone you request a band for. When you present the form in Registration, if any signature looks un-original, you will not receive a band for that person. Parent must sign for anyone under the age of 7.

After your team finishes, individuals banded as team members and family should gather at the finish line just outside the entrance gate. You will need to show your band and picture ID at the gate. When the team finishes their interviews, they will be directed to pull down to the bottom of the ramp, then individuals with wristbands for that team will be permitted to enter for pictures. At no time can any family or friends go up on the ramp.

Banded Drivers of Record, Riders of Record, Co-Drivers, Co-riders, or Navigators will have access to the Controlled Access Area and be permitted to go up on the ramp.

SCORE is making special arrangements at San Felipe to allow team members, family and friends to sign waivers at the entrance of the finish area. All team members must have a picture id if under the age of 12. Plan ahead as signing of the waivers may take some time. Registration staff will be in the finish area starting at 12pm on Saturday to assist you in this process.

There will be no access at the start of the race beyond the gated entrances to the ramp. If a vehicle encounters a problem in the start area the SCORE staff may allow a banded team member to enter the area to assist. If you have not obtained bands at Registration there may be delays in locating and processing a team member. You will be given your original start time so every second counts.

Teams with individuals who register as Media will work with Dominic Clark to obtain wristbands and identify what areas they can shoot from at each event. New for 2019, team Media credential requests must be submitted by March 22. There will be NO LATE, on-site registration.

We thank all of you for racing with SCORE. We are making this process as easy as possible. Please keep in mind that safety of all individuals is the purpose of these changes.
