



## 2019 SCORE Baja 500 Important Race Reminders # 2



- **Full Course GPS Files will be released at 6:00pm on Tuesday, May 28th.**  
Complete files will include sections from start to Rm 30.41 and returning from Rm 456.76 to finish line. **NO** additional reminder email will be sent announcing this GPS release.
- **Chassis Inspections and Pre-Tech** will be on Thursday, May 30th on Adolfo Lopez Mateos (a.k.a. First St.) in downtown Ensenada. Vehicles that pre-tech Thursday will have preference moving through the tech line on Friday, May 31st.
- **A Banded Race Participant (Driver/Co-Driver or Rider/Co-Rider,)** must operate the vehicle at all times when moving through the contingency/tech inspection line. Participant must be behind wheel or control steering while walking beside vehicle. No navigators are allowed to drive or steer a vehicle through the line. *Only exception is Navigators for TT Legends entries.*
- **Driving Race Vehicles on public streets.** We have been advised that your race vehicles can be driven to and from the Estero Beach location.
- **Race Vehicles** will not be allowed to enter the tech/contingency inspection line until a banded Race Participant is with the vehicle, and they have the Race Packet (Driver Packet) with the Contingency Form completed.
- **Required Wristbands** – For wristbands and Race Packet, a team member must first go to registration. Refer to the Schedule of Events for all registration times. For the Baja 500, registrations will be done at the Estero Beach facility in the Mayapan Room.
- **IMPORTANT - All Participants** – Drivers and Co-Drivers must present helmet, driving suit and HNR device for approval. Moto and quad riders must present helmet for approval.
- **Top 10 Trophy Trucks in Points** are invited to lead the tech line Friday beginning at 9:00am.
- **Upgrading from Stella III to Stella III EVO units is Mandatory** - If you currently have a Stella III unit you can purchase a Stella III EVO upgrade kit consisting of new wiring and antenna for your current device. Complete new Stella III EVO units, and Stella III upgrade kits and brackets will be available at Thursday Pre-Tech and during Friday Tech inspection. On-site purchases are cash only on these days.
- **Friday Participant Meetings are Mandatory** - Rider Meeting for Motos and Quads is **5:00pm** and Driver Meeting is **8:00pm**. Meetings will be at Estero Beach Concert Court. A banded member of each race team must attend their respective meeting.
- **Team Support Persons** – Pit crews, family and friends, must sign waivers and receive wristbands to enter post-race interview area. Waiver forms are available on our website. To save time, team support members can complete waivers before race weekend and bring to registration to receive wristbands. Up to 10 bands will be available for each race entry.
- **Hydration is a must for all racers!** Do not wait until race morning to start to hydrate! Experts recommend starting at least 48 hours before strenuous exercise! All vehicles will be checked for on-board water for occupants before start line.
- **Moto and Quad Riders** are required to utilize a hydration pack (CamelBak® or equivalent)! Minimum liquid capacity is one (1) liter, and two (2) liter size is required if temperature is expected over 80° F (26.7° C). Riders will be checked at start line and not allowed to start without water.
- **Moto and Quad Riders** are required to have a rear facing high-intensity flashing LED light on their helmet or upper area of backpack. These lights will be checked during tech inspection and also in start and finish areas on race day.
- **Banded Race Participants** - Must wear SCORE issued wristbands for entry into start/finish area. Do not remove your band until race conclusion!
