



## Course Revision Announced

Course layout for the 52nd SCORE Baja 1000 has been revised. Course mileage is now 800.50 miles (1288.24 Km).

Recently some incidents occurred in the Pine Forest area during another organizations event. Due to those incidents, the Pine Forest area is no longer available for motorsports events.

This recent ban on using this area required SCORE to establish a new section to replace that part of the 2019 Baja 1000 course. After a huge effort by our layout team, we have developed a new section while keeping the total race mileage to 800.50 miles!

Starting at approximately Rm 630, the revised course now turns south into some challenging territory that has not been a part of SCORE races in recent years. From this point to the Pre-Run ending point at Rm 765.90 is the revised section.

Complete revised course map is now available on our website under Race Info. GPS files will post at 6 pm Thursday, the 24th.

Shortcut locations and mileages for Classes 7sx, BC, 9, 11 and all Sportsman classes remain the same as on the preliminary map.

### IMPORTANT NOTES

Driver/Rider meeting will be **Wednesday, Nov. 20** at 7:00 pm at Torre Lucerna Hotel in Ensenada.

- Moto/Quad classes start at 3:00 am and Trucks/Buggies start at 10:30 am on Friday, the 22nd. Time Limit is 34 hours.
- After Nov. 11 registration close, all race registrations must be done onsite in Ensenada during race week. An additional fee will be required.
- Participation in all four (4) 2019 SCORE races is required to be championship eligible.
