DEFINITION

GENERAL REGULATIONS

SCORE recognizes all Jeepspeed® specifications, competition rules and regulations currently in effect for their respective classes.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS

SCORE Competition Regulations will take precedent over any conflict pertaining to Jeepspeed rules

NOTE: SCORE CR 1 requires Head and Neck Restraints

Refer to current Jeepspeed Rule Book for vehicle specifications.

All entries must meet SCORE Competition Regulations in effect at time of event.

Number Range 1700-1799

1700 - Jeepspeed® Challenge Class

Engine 6-cylinder max. - Tires 33" Max.

Maximum suspension travel: Front 10" - Rear 12"

One Shock per wheel

Number Range 2700-2799

2700 – Jeepspeed Intermediate Class

Forced Induction - Any 4 or 6-cylinder Dodge or Jeep engine

Maximum suspension travel: Front 12" - Rear 14"

Tires up to 35" - Two shocks per wheel

Number Range 3700-3799

3700 - Jeepspeed® Outlaw Class

Any Dodge or Jeep modified chassis and body

Any make production/crate engine

Maximum suspension travel: Front 15" - Rear 24" - Shocks Open

Numbers 4700-4799

Open - Jeepspeed® Trophy Class

Frame and chassis are open

Any make production/crate engine

Maximum suspension travel: Front 15" - Rear Open - Shocks Open

Class currently is combined with 3700 above.
