Responding to further analysis of information and forecasts for the Corona Virus (COVID-19) situation with Mexican authorities, race teams and sponsors, SCORE International is announcing the new dates and site for the 52nd BFGoodrich Tires SCORE Baja 500 presented by 4 Wheel Parts.

The race will now take place in San Felipe from September 22-27 and will include qualifying for Trophy Truck, Trophy Truck Legends, Class 1 and Trophy Truck Spec classes.

Finishing positions in the 52nd SCORE Baja 500 will determine start positions for the 53rd SCORE Baja 1000. The results of both races will define the 2020 SCORE World Desert Points Championship.

Teams registered for the San Felipe 250 will have your paid fees transferred to your account. The paid fees will be available to apply to your Baja 500 entry.

SCORE International will apply official Health Protocols for race logistics and will work in coordination for the application of official Health Protocols by Hotels, Restaurants and other services providers.
