

STELLA III EVO SYSTEM FEATURES

The use of the Stella III EVO System is mandatory at all SCORE races. The system is used by SCORE Race Operations to make races safer, especially in events where there are both motos/quads and four-wheel vehicles. SCORE also utilizes the data tracking for VCP and speed penalty reporting.

The video you are about to watch includes features used by both off road and rally types of races. Below is a list of features utilized and not utilized by SCORE Race Operations.

SCORE highly recommends that in addition to DORs/Co-drivers and Riders/Co-riders, all team members and friends attending a race view the video and learn how to operate the device in the event they are at the scene of an emergency.

Request for "Good Samaritan" Time Credit – If you stop to assist another racer who is in need of life saving immediate medical assistance you may be eligible for a time credit for the time you are stopped, Refer to section 10-5 of the Racer Brief for complete details.
